

The Dead Sea Scrolls

A Talk by Steve Taverner

at Fleet Methodist Church on Wednesday 27th February (7.15 for 7.30pm)

The Dead Sea Scrolls have intrigued both Christians and non-Christians alike since their chance discovery by a boy throwing a stone into a cave in 1947. A short time ago Steve gave a fascinating talk on this subject at Fleet Baptist Church and we are fortunate that he has agreed to come to Fleet Methodist Church.

Amongst the issues that will be covered are:

- What are the Dead Sea Scrolls?
- Where were they found?
- Who wrote the Scrolls?
- What were the key beliefs and practices described in the Scrolls?
- What do they tell us about Scripture in Jesus' Day?
- Why are the Scrolls valuable for Christians?
