Yateley Choral Society returns with full force in 2022 to confront Haydn's energetic and tempestuous *Missa in Angustiis*, more commonly known as the Nelson Mass. The piece encompasses an enormous range of emotion; playfulness, poignancy, terror, and optimism, with a touch of *schadenfreude* thrown in for good measure. Also on the menu is Handel's ravishing Zadok the Priest, with its famous introduction known so well at coronations and royal weddings. In the royal theme, and in this Jubilee year, we perform William Boyce's vivacious *The King Shall Rejoice* composed for the coronation of William III in 1761. Mozart makes a cheeky appearance too, with his *Laudate Dominum*, a favourite for Classic FM listeners. This stunning gem for soprano soloist and choir is bound to transport you to a place beyond the bounds of this earth.

We are thrilled to be joined in this performance by West Forest Sinfonia and four outstanding professional soloists. The orchestra will play Holst's beautifully nostalgic *St Paul's Suite*, and accompany the choir and soloists in Handel's little-known early work *Nisi Dominus*.
